THE COMPANY

Normandie Logistique has operated from the Normandy region of France for 50 years. BACKGROUND

The Group's activities require a whole range of software applications: invoicing, storage, transport, payroll and more. With each of these activities essential to business operations, they necessitate a total of around 20 virtual servers. Over many years, the Normandie Logistique Group has been developing a rigorous quality process to ensure it can fully meet its clients' expectations.

This is why its IT infrastructure is based on a Microsoft Hyper-V cluster, providing a high level of real-time availability. The result, all in all, is several terabytes of data that need to be safeguarded.
